TATTOO AFTERCARE:

Keep the tattoo covered with bandage for no longer than 2 hours. Remove bandage and wash with soap and warm water- be sure all surface blood and excess ink is removed. Lightly pat dry. Apply a very thin layer of ointment- Aquaphor, A&D, Tattoo Goo, etc. DO NOT REBANDAGE your new tattoo unless working under dirty conditions. Keeping the tattoo clean during the first 2 weeks of healing is extremely important. Continue to wash & apply a thin layer of ointment to your tattoo 2 to 3 times a day only, for the first 2 to 3 days only. On the 3rd/4th day, switch to a body/hand lotion with no heavy dyes or perfumes- Aveeno, Curel, Johnson & Johnson, etc. Continue to apply to tattoo 2 to 3 times a day for the next week or two. As the tattoo heals it will peel and flake. At which time it is extremely important not to PICK, SCRATCH or SCRUB the tattoo. Picking will pull out your color and may cause scarring. DO NOT SWIM, SAUNA, TUB SOAK, EXPOSE TO PROLONGED SUN or TAN FOR 2 WEEKS MINIMUM. DO NOT APPLY HYDROGEN PEROXIDE, ALCO-HOL, BACITRACIN, NEOSPORIN OR VASELINE. Avoid long showers or prolonged shower spray and sunblock lotions until your scab is completely off. If the tattoo becomes inflamed (extremely red, irritated or oozing puss) please call the shop immediately. After tattoo has healed, use a sunblock of SPF 45 or higher when exposed to prolong sun (more than 15 minutes) to keep your tattoo from fading. Use a cloth to cover tattoo while using a tanning booth. Tanning WILL destroy your tattoo over time.

Failure to follow these instructions will result in touch-ups that will be charged for.
